## 11 Day Pilgrimage to the Holy Land April 8 - 18, 2013 \$3996 per person

Father Bart Hutcherson, has been invited to serve as Spiritual Director on an 11 day Holy Land Pilgrimage. He will co-lead with Mrs. Erin Blanchette, the director of Vine of Grace, a local women's spirituality ministry. The pilgrimage will visit many of the sites in Galilee, Nazareth, Bethlehem and Jerusalem associated with the life and ministry of Jesus. Additionally, it will visit numerous sites associated with the Hebrew Scriptures and our religious heritage. The cost of the trip is \$3996 per person. This price will include airfare (from Phoenix), all lodging (double occupancy) and ground transportation in Israel, all breakfasts and dinners, all portage fees, tips.
