MOBILE MEALS OF TUCSON

Mobile Meals of Tucson, Inc. helps preserve the health, dignity and independence of homebound adults by delivering meals. It is a volunteer based, non-profit organization dedicated to providing meals to homebound adults to help them maintain their health and remain living independently. Volunteers deliver meals, and provide social contact and a connection to other community organizations. Clients are eligible if they are homebound, have special dietary needs, and are unable to cook or shop for themselves. Clients are provided with two meals a day, Monday-Friday.

Volunteer Opportunities:

Drivers: 1 ½ hrs per day, once a week, mid-day, or substitute on an on-call basis. Mileage reimbursement is available.

Driver Scheduler: Work from home; 1 to 3 hrs per week.

Paperwork Liaison: Clerical support for driver paperwork. Some driving involved; 2 hrs per week.

Client Interviewer: Visit potential clients by appointment to evaluate eligibility for Mobile Meals; 3+ hrs per week.

Office Volunteers: various office duties such as answering phones, data entry and filing; 3+ hrs, 1 day a week, morning or afternoon.
