**Marriage:** Couples who would like to celebrate this Sacrament should contact one of the priests proposed wedding date.

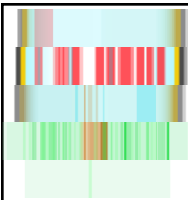
**Infant Baptisms:** Infant Baptisms are celebrated at Sunday Masses. Please call Susan to schedule baptisms & preparation classes.

### WHEN GOD CALLS, HOW DO YOU ANSWER?

Will you answer? Will you listen? Will you follow?

Could God be calling you to the next Ignatian Silent Retreat? Fr. Sean Carroll, SJ, Jesuit priest and Executive Director of the Kino Border Initiative will lead this year's retreat, Social Justice in the Ignatian Way, from Friday evening September 20 to Sunday noon, September 22. He will speak to us of following the Lord Jesus in serving humankind, as did St. Ignatius, of letting the Spirit lead us in action that arises from contemplation.

In the beautifully peaceful setting of the Redemptorist Renewal Center we gather both to hear Fr. Sean and to listen to what God will speak in our hearts as we consider the unity of charity and justice, faith and works in our responsibility to care the littlest and the weakest among us: the poor and marginalized, the unborn and young, those disabled by age or disease, and the migrant.

Silence is a critical element of this retreat. The presentations interspersed will be rooted in the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius, the wellspring of Ignatian Spirituality.

No previous experience of the Exercises is necessary to benefit from this retreat. Each year God brings together persons completely new to Ignatian Spirituality with veterans of many retreats, and everybody in-between. We all walk together in the silence of this time and God meets us where we are.
