DEVASTATION IN NEPAL

As we have seen in the newspapers and on the nightly news, Nepal experienced a 7.8 earthquake and several aftershocks that have left thousands of people dead and many thousands injured. The devastation is astounding.

Our diocese has had a close relationship with Nepal, especially through Father Silas Bogati, a priest of the Vicariate of Katmandu in Nepal who has visited frequently in our diocese and spoken at a number of our parishes.

Catholic Relief Services has begun to provide emergency relief. On Sunday, May 10th we will take up a second collection to help relieve and alleviate some of the suffering and loss of life and property that has taken place.

Please be generous as we seek to help our brothers and sisters in Nepal. Your contribution will make a big difference.

- Summer permits are \$35 for each session (pre-session, Session 1, and Session 2) or \$100 for the entire summer.
- Fall permits are \$100.
- Save money & purchase a yearly parking permit for \$270 (valid Aug. 2015-Aug. 2016)

Those receiving permits will be notified by May 30. No special status will be granted to people who've previously had a permit.
