## FR. JOHN PAUL'S SPIRITUAL BREW:

**O**ur Sunday Readings call us to have a deep experience of the inner workings of God's profound and perfect love.

We are told in our first reading from Sirach: "if you trust in God, you too shall live; for God has set before you fire and water; to whichever you choose stretch forth your hand"

These readings are calling us into a relationship of trust with God where we will be tested. This test is more like a formative period where our gifts will be drawn forth, our weakness will be exposed, and our potential will be shown to us.

As a Novice, (the first of an eight year journey of formation and preparation to become a Dominican Friar) I was first introduced to the depths of prayer, study, community, and service. It was a life changing experience that altered my heart, mind, and spirit. It helped me to be more generous, open, patient, and prayerful. It taught me how to think deeply, and broaden my perspective on how I perceived God, society and loving people. In today's Gospel, Jesus says, "Do not think that I've come to abolish the law and the prophets.. I have come not to abolish but to fulfill them". He invites his hearers into a true "metanoia" (a new mind or an above mind - that allows one to experience the truth and to allow what is false and distracting to fall away) and to truly experience "the spirit of the Mosaic Law," as well, as "the letter" and to fulfill it.. as the "God who is God" intends and calls us to loving action.

This weekend we are blessed to have our six Novices and their Novice-master, Fr. Anthony Rosevear, OP, with us to experience and learn about our mission, ministry, and community life at the Newman Center. Please welcome them, as they see and experience how God's beautiful and mysterious spirit is very active in our community.
