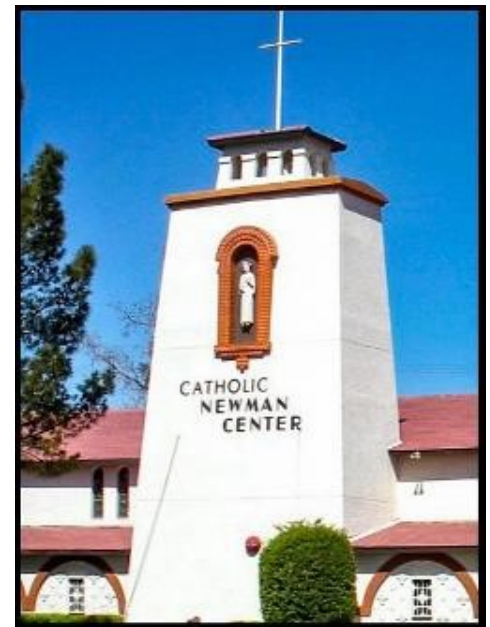

Fr. John Paul's Spiritual Brew

P "Peace be with you" is a powerful phrase and echo that we hear throughout the Easter Season. It's Christ's invitation to his followers to allow the 'healing balm' of 'resurrected love' to remain with and in his followers.

Peace be with you...., in, around, and through... everything that we do... is that 'beat' that Christ wants us to get into our hearts, souls, and lives.... It is a peace... that heals the broken hearted; gives sight to blind, frees those "tomed in" by lack of opportunity, community, friendship, and soul.

In today's Gospel Jesus returns again post his appearance to two of his disciples of the road to Emmaus. He uses "resurrected peace" to invite his followers beyond the fear of seeing and experiencing his Risen Glory as some scary and distant..., but as something to be embraced and salvific. He eats in their company, so that they can see and "remember" that this is truly "him" their teacher, friend, and Lord... who really walked and physically accompanied them in the flesh..

Jesus invites you and I to this same table fellowship every time we share the Eucharist at Mass. May we have the courage to "look beyond the bread we eat, to see our savior and Lord, to beyond the cup we drink, to see his life poured out as blood" Let us continue to walk in the Glory of Easter Peace, and allow its wonderful effects... to raise and renew all around us! Alleluia

It gives me great joy to welcome Fr. Emmanuel Taylor, OP, who will be arriving in July as our new associate pastor/director. May God's peace surround him, Fr. Thomas, all of our Dominican ministries, and all of us, as we peacefully transit into God's call to new life.

This letter comes to you in the joy of the Easter Season. Jesus is alive and risen, Alleluia! Easter is about change. Jesus' glorified body was different than this pre-resurrection one. The disciples were changed. And, over time the world has been changed. As St. Paul says, "we have become a new creation." Once, again there is change. Unfortunately, because of timing this announcement comes to you in a written form instead of personally, as Fr. John Paul and I would prefer. My prearranged vacation prevented me from being present when this announcement is made.



Part of Dominican life is a change of assignments. Pastors usually change every six years and Associates every three years for example. Some of you may not know that I am actually a member of the Central Province headquartered in Chicago. Officially, I am "on loan" to the Western Province. In discernment with Fr. Mark Padrez, O.P., Prior-Provincial of the Western Province, in July I am being transferred to St. Dominic's Catholic Church in Los Angeles, CA. Most importantly, know that this was a mutual decision, embraced by both of us, as part of my future Dominican discernment. This is a welcome decision and an important one in my spiritual journey. While I wholeheartedly embrace and celebrate this decision, know that there is sadness in leaving a community that I have grown to love and cherish. My two years at Tucson have been a great joy. The Dominican Community of Frs. John Paul, Tom, and Nathan; and sisters Angelica and Mary Virginia have been a great blessing in my life. The parish community has been welcoming and receptive to allowing me to express my gifts in the RCIA and Art & Environment. Thank you for your openness, hospitality, and support.

Upon my return we will have a reception after the 9:00 AM Mass on May 6, 2018, while the students are present, to acknowledge this change of assignment. Please know that a piece of my heart will always be in Tucson and I intend to visit when I can. God bless you and let us keep praying for one another.

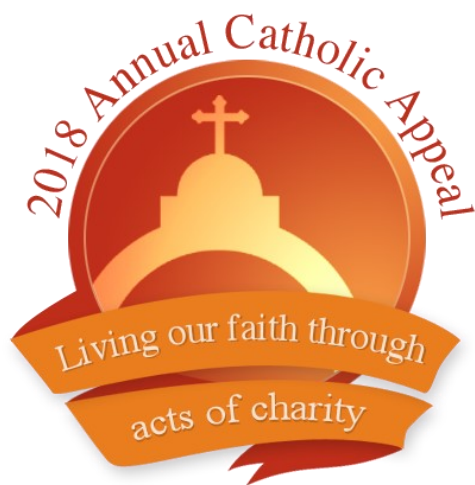
