Fr. John Paul's Spiritual Brew

If I could only touch the tassel of his garment, I will be made whole”.

What a great statement of faith from today's Gospel! Jesus has been asked by an official's assistant to come and heal his daughter who is seriously ill. Jesus responds and, along the way through a pressing crowd, he is touched by a woman who has been impacted with illness for many years, is near to broke, and seeking healing. He is curious and drawn to her persistence - despite her weakened condition, to have enough 'faith' to push through adversity, and to "touch his garments." That is a lot of energy and risk - to put forward for something that could have failed!

Jesus finds her and asks why did she do this? Fearful that she has been noticed, she comes forward and shares her story... Jesus only sees the power of her faith realized. He continues on his journey to a sick little girl, and despite doubt and fear from others.. He pushes through... to grasp the little girl by the hand, and say "Little girl, get up! The young girl does, is fed, and returns to life with her family.

God wants us to cultivate a relationship with him... If we do, whether times are bright or opaque... we can 'push through' and touch Him. May we have the courage to not make excuses about how to approach our God, but to simply reach out and do it! Amen.
