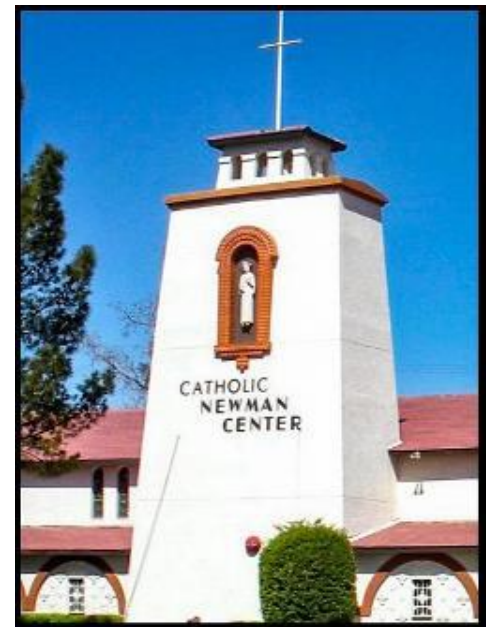

Fr. John Paul's Spiritual Brew

Our Sunday readings invite us to take pause and to reflect on this question: Where are you?

In the first reading from the Book of Genesis, Adam and Eve have eaten from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, and now they are hiding from God who is walking through the garden. God calls out where are you? They emerge from the bushes with leaves for clothes because they now realize that they are naked. Prior to eating from the tree they did not have this awareness, or this distraction.., now they do, among other things.. that pull their attention away from simply being cared for by God.

Where we are in our lives can determine how much peace of mind we have. If we are always on the go, any reflective time can be a torture... If we are in reflective mode.. any call to action can be a moment of frustration or bother! God invites us into the world, and into relationship with it. It is all the work of God's hands, and we are called into some union with it.

Today's Gospel reminds us that God does not work against Godself. Jesus in casting out an unclean spirit is criticized by those jealous of his good work, as able to do this because he is the prince of these unclean spirits. Jesus dismisses their insecurities and reminds all listening that God is about unity, and freedom.. and does not work against this good.

As we hear these readings and reflect on where we are personally, may we ask for the courage to ground ourselves in the relationships that bring life, and aid us in the work of building the Kingdom of God. Amen!
