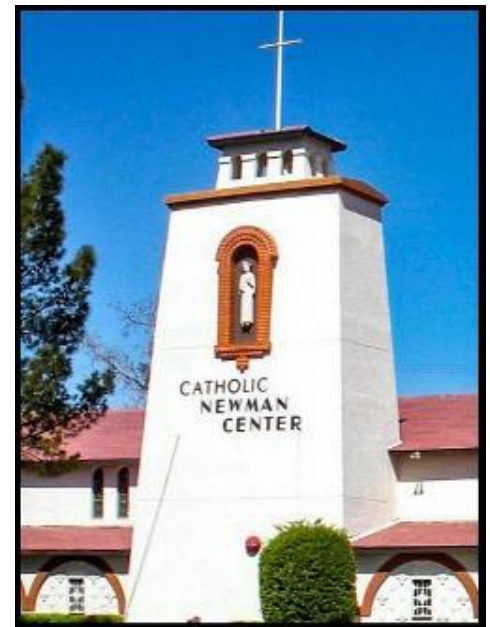

## *Fr. John Paul's Spiritual Brew*

**M**other Teresa once said “to do small things with great love”. This simple statement speaks of the power of intentionally.

Today's Gospel recounts the parable of the 'mustard seed' as a symbol for the expanding Kingdom of God. What appears to be extremely tiny.. contains within it the power and potential to become a large shrub that provides shade and shelter.
