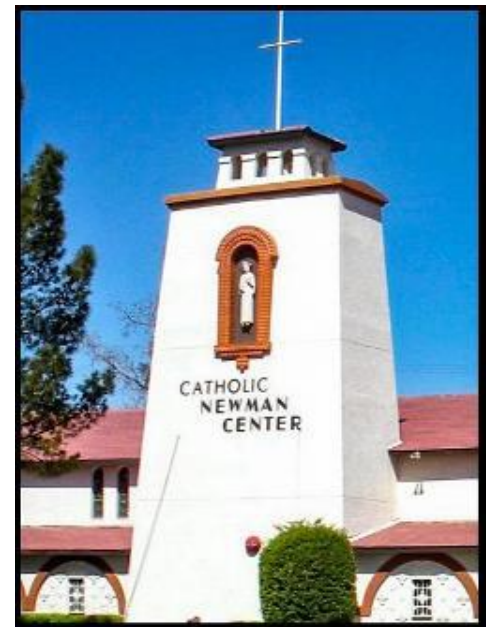

John the Baptist is a figure who both inspires and points the way to Christ. This Solemnity of his birth is always celebrated near the first day of summer - when the longest day occurs, and then begin to tick down to the longest night in December - marking the first day of winter, the longest night, and the Solemnity of the birth of Jesus Christ!

We are called as a pilgrim people to preach the Light of God in Christ by how you and I proclaim Christ with our lives. How do we bring healing and recovery of sight in our time and place?
