Fr. John Paul's Spiritual Brew

We want to sit one at your right, and the other at your left”
Sometimes we talk without thinking. Someone is speaking about something important, and we are not really paying attention to them... but daydreaming about what we want to hear. Then comes that precious, or shocking ‘splash’ of ‘cold water’ in our faces! And, we wake up... and begin to really ‘listen’ to what is being said.... It is here, and now... that we can say, “yes” or “no” to someone with real ownership!

In Mark’s Gospel... the disciples are often invited to “really listen” to what Jesus is saying! He calls them ‘constantly’ to go deeper, to take courage, and not be so distracted! And, today’s Gospel is another example!

Jesus is speaking about mission.... and they are distracted by position... Jesus is calling them to truly let go and live..... they are clinging to security, and posturing for importance.

To be a true follower of Jesus means to give your life away... to be interested in how to make the lives of others better... And, to not be so self focused. We have many opportunities to do this..... especially among those who are strangers, or close to us..... What will we do?

The Spirit of the Lord is Upon us, and we have been anointed! Amen!
