Fr. John Paul's Spiritual Brew

To give from our need, and not just from our surplus”

To give a proper gift to someone is an art form. Have you ever received a gift, and then said thank you sheepishly? Thinking to yourself, “what were they thinking? or, how can I recycle this? We’ve probably all had this experience at least once or twice? It’s not the worse thing that could happen to you, but it’s always a little memorable when you compare that to a thoughtful gift... that strikes you in your heart, mind, and soul... There’s no comparison.. Someone took the time to really think about ‘their gift-giving’ and, gave us a gift from their heart, and discernment... and, not just from their ‘surplus’..., thus not really seeing what was needed, and responding.

To really give takes energy... whether this is our time, talents, or treasure... It takes courage and real generosity to do so....

In the Gospel... the poor widow... one who did not have any kind of a surplus.... gives from a place of real generosity! She’s giving from a different kind of surplus.... namely, the treasure in heaven which she has built up in this life. What is this treasure? It’s the treasure that comes from loving God with all that we are, and allowing this to inform our actions. It’s acting out of that place which says that God’s Spirit is really upon me, and with me.... and that feeling this touch... I will continue to move through life with faith, hope, and love... into any situation. This is all that widow had to give, and she gives it freely!

The love of God is given to us, not just for us... but to be given away. May we have the courage to be generous. Amen!
