CAMINO DE SANTIAGO PILGRIMAGE

The seed for the 2019 Camino de Santiago was planted in 2015 when parishioners Genevieve and Ernie Gallardo made the pilgrimage together. They walked 100 miles to Santiago, Spain and the cathedral holding the remains of St. James the Apostle. The experience was so powerful that they were determined to return someday. They invited their friends. Seven of those friends made plans to join them in June of this year. We will give them a blessing at the 9AM Mass.

They are called the Tumamoc 9 since they have been climbing that challenging hill almost daily for two years. The elevation gain on Day One of the Camino Walk is equal to four times up Tumamoc. It is a great physical challenge.

The spiritual challenge of the Camino can be summed up with the phrase "Embrace Your Journey." They feel humbled knowing that they are walking on a route that has been shared by pilgrims for well over a thousand years. They will each bring their own hopes along with prayers for family, friends, church and country.

Somewhere it says God invented the Camino so that humans would know how they are supposed to treat each other.

The "Tumamoc 9" look forward to this journey together along with meeting new friends from all over the world that they will meet along the way.
