Fr. John Paul's Spiritual Brew

You give them some food to eat yourselves" A powerful theme from this Sunday's Gospel.

Corpus Christi - the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ!

As the Spirit of the Lord continues to shower down upon each of us.. so does the call to be united and fed "in Christ"

How appropriate it is that the call for unity comes from Christ, who is the redeemer, and feeder of our souls! Christ is our way, truth, and life.... the Word spoken, and offered as "balm" for all - that separates us from one another.

In today's Gospel, Jesus invites his followers to be attentive to the personal needs of a congregation who is feeling served by his message, and is feeling the need for hospitality and feeding - to continue to 'encounter' the power of his word in action.

May God's Spirit continue to blow across the action of our summer adventures, the day's heat, and our soul's questions and truth seeking. May we be fed deeply, and feed others with care. Amen!
