Fr. John Paul's Spiritual Brew

e are hoping for some good refreshing monsoons this summer in Tucson! These are seasonal rains that fall all over our state with force and power, and don't discriminate upon whom they shower.

In our readings today from Isaiah and Matthew we are reminded that God's rain, snow, and seed fall with freedom and without judgment everywhere, and upon every living person and thing.

God's desire for each of us is to flourish and not flounder, and this is why God pours down grace and mercy in such abundance. In the Gospel, God is the sower who spreads seeds broadly and with wreckless abandon! The seeds are going everywhere! On the path, in shallow, rocky, thorny, and good soil. God's generosity in spreading the seeds appears to have no limits.

The lesson here is that God's grace is abundant, and that God only wants to give it away. If received well, growth will go through the roof. If received tepidly, it will grow still, but not with the full effect, and the energy of an open heart.
