## *Fr. John Paul's Spiritual Brew*

**S**hake the dust from your feet.”

I remember as a child coming in from a rainy day, or an afternoon at the beach, and having to shake water or sand from my clothing, umbrella, or shoes. I was always reminded that there was a place to do this, so that water, dirt, or sand would not get into the house, and not create a dirty living environment.

In the Gospel, Jesus sends his followers out to preach and witness God's kingdom... He tells them not to carry anything that is unnecessary, and to take only what is needed.

What do we need to take as we are called to proclaim God's action in our lives to others? Jesus suggests that anything that could be a distraction to the mission needs to be left behind. Maybe things that we've become too dependent on, such as: too much technology, how-to books, substances, addictive behaviors, co-dependent relationships, workaholic attitudes, and fear of healthy changes in our lives, etc... These things can be apart of our human condition, and Christ is warning us to "shake them off of our feet" as they become an incumbrance to our mission and call.... to proclaim and grow in God.

May we have the courage to embrace what is beneficial to the expansion of God's kingdom in our personal lives and world, and "Shake Off" all that is contrary.
