Fr. John Paul's Spiritual Brew

The power of the Easter Season calls us to more than remembrance-it invites us to carry the hope of the Resurrection beyond the pages of Scripture and into our hearts, our relationships, and the fabric of our daily lives.

Today, we hear Jesus commissioning his followers to go into the whole world and proclaim the love and promise of the Triune God to all people. But how do we do this in a world saturated with noise, skepticism, and division?

We do it gradually, faithfully, and abundantly. Yes, there are countless reasons to hesitate. Yet, if we long for real renewal—a transformation that goes deeper than surface-level change—we must accept the challenge to rise above the exhaustion of war, political strife, social inequality, religious division, and the many forms of suffering that unsettle the human spirit.

Jesus's final command to his disciples was clear and urgent: **Go! Go and baptize. Go and heal. Preach. Lift up. Build bridges. Forgive. Reconcile. See. Love. Bring peace. Come, Holy Spirit, and renew the face of the earth.**

The Holy Spirit stirs us to action and reminds us of the angels' words at the Ascension: "Why do you stand here looking up toward heaven? Go-share all that I have taught you. And remember, I am with you always." This is the Great Commission—and the divine promise of accompaniment.

May we feel that same holy push—the gentle but persistent urging of the Holy Spirit—to continue Jesus's mission of love, healing, and renewal in our world today.

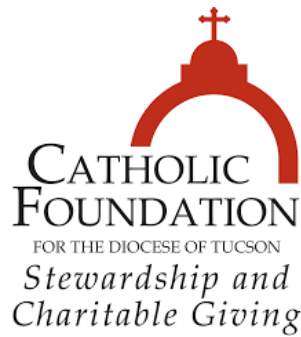
