## Fr. John Paul's Spiritual Brew

**G**ive them something to eat yourselves" (Luke 9:11-17).

Today's bold words from Jesus take us to the heart of Corpus Christi—the celebration of the Body and Blood of Christ. The Eucharist is not just a personal moment with God; it is the Church's source of unity and mission. Here, we are not only gathered—we are transformed.

In the afterglow of Pentecost, the Spirit continues to invite us: come, be fed, be sent. The Eucharist gives us what we need to become Christ's presence in a hurting world. Jesus, the Bread of Life, is broken and poured out—not only for us, but through us.

This sacrament calls us to participate, to let Christ into the depths of our lives so that we may become His hands and heart for others. The Eucharist strengthens us to be just, compassionate, and hospitable—especially in a world marked by unrest, division, and pain. In our cities, in our communities, and across the globe—from Ukraine, the Middle East, and Los Angeles—to our own neighborhoods—the Eucharist compels us to respond not with fear or blame, but with faith, hope, and love. It is Christ's body broken to restore unity, His blood poured out to reconcile. So how do we begin? By coming to the table again and again—letting Jesus feed what is hungry in us, calm what is anxious, and strengthen what is weak.

May we have the courage to receive what He longs to give: Himself. And may we, nourished by His presence, become ministers of peace—not through bullying and noise, but through the peaceful steady witness of Eucharistic love.

**"Love your enemies. Do good. Expect nothing in return." (Luke 6:35) And may we live this love—especially when it's hardest.**

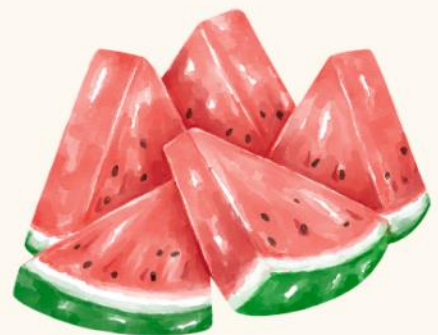
