## Fr. John Paul's Spiritual Brew

e are drawn into a Gospel that echoes the theme from our 2022-2023 academic year: "For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be." It's a timeless reminder that we are stewards of all that God has entrusted to us—our time, talents, relationships, and resources. As I reflect on the week past—including the joyful chaos of ComicCon— I'm reminded of a famous line from Spider-Man: "With great power comes great responsibility."
