



Fr. John Paul's Spiritual Brew

Over the next three Sundays, the Gospels will continue drawing us into the essential themes of prayer, discipleship, and stewardship—core practices that shape and sustain our walk with Christ.

This Sunday, July 27, we encounter the disciples asking Jesus, “Lord, teach us to pray.” Jesus responds not with a technique, but with a relationship: “When you pray, say, ‘Father...’” He invites them—and us—to enter prayer through the door of intimate trust in God as a loving Father. Why is this important? Because when we have a relationship grounded in love and goodness, we can ask. And we can ask boldly, persistently, and with care.

We see this modeled in the first reading, where Abraham intercedes for Sodom and Gomorrah—not once, but repeatedly—pleading for mercy for the sake of the few just souls within. True prayer is not transactional. It’s relational. It’s about honesty before God, the courage to ask, and the grace to persevere.

Amen! Alleluia!


Salvavision is dedicated to providing comprehensive support to asylum seekers and deportees in Nogales, Sonora.
